

Diploma of Occupational Health and Safety (BSB51307)

Description This qualification reflects the role of individuals who coordinate and maintain the OHS program within an organisation. Possible job titles relevant to this qualification include: Occupational Health and Safety Manager, Occupational Health and Safety Practitioner and Senior Occupational Health and Safety Officer.

This course aims to give students:

- skills to better implement and monitor the organisation's OHS management systems
- skills to better manage OHS participative arrangements and risk assessment processes
- the knowledge to ensure compliance with OHS legislative requirements
- skills to implement OHS initiatives and processes that support organisational OHS goals and objectives.

This course is delivered under auspice agreement with the Australian College of Training and Employment RTO number 31455.

Pre-requisites Entry into the Diploma requires participants to have sufficient numeracy and literacy skills to read and comprehend instruction for referencing legislation, preparing reports, completing assessments and essay writing. Preferred pathways into the qualification include: achieving BSB41407 Certificate IV in Occupational Health and Safety or equivalent, evidence of competency in majority of units required for BSB41407 or extensive vocational experience in health and safety roles.

Students must have access to a workplace while undertaking this qualification.

Competency standards There are 8 units of competency that need to be completed to gain this qualification. Of these units 5 are core units and 3 of them are electives.
