

Diploma of Training and Assessment (TAA50104)

Description This course has been specifically designed for students who are currently engaged in advanced training and assessment practice. The focus of the course is on the development of advanced skills and knowledge essential for the design, development, management and evaluation of training and assessments systems.

This course would ideally suit:

- VET professionals such as workplace or RTO based trainers and assessors requiring advanced skills/knowledge.
- New training managers or human resource personnel who are responsible for the design, development and monitoring of training and/or assessment systems.
- Individuals who are setting up or managing training and assessment systems.

This course is delivered under auspice agreement with the Australian College of Training and Employment RTO number 31455.

Pre-requisites Entrants to the Diploma must have the core units of the TAA40104 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment or be able to demonstrate equivalent competence.
